River Dell freshman stars

HACKENSACK - Mike Esposito isn't alone in enjoying the holiday break from his studies at Brown. His younger brother, Jim, a River Dell freshman, is making the most of Mike's homecoming.

"He's been such an influence on me since he got home," said Jim, who had a major influence last night on the Bergen County Coaches Holiday Wrestling Tournament. "Michael pushes me and gets me psyched up."

Jim took care of the rest, dropping down a weight class to 108 and using a lateral drop to perfection while pinning all three opponents to reach today's 3 p.m. semifinal round at Hackensack High. Pascack Hills, team champion eight of the last nine years, again took control of that department, taking a 1241/2-1141/2 lead over Bergenfield. Six

Cowboys and four Bears advanced. Esposito was one of several upstarts who shocked the crowd during yesterday's first three rounds. Fort Lee sophomore George Triant stunned defending district champion Paul Zimmerman of Pascack Hills, 10-9, in a 122-pound firstrounder. Triant, especially adept on his feet, built a 10-4 lead over his more experienced opponent.

Lyndhurst senior John Ross surprised Bergenfield district champion Andy

Leonard at 135. Ross caught Leonard overdriving on a pin attempt and nailed him in 2:35. Bergen Catholic junior John Mackert upset a district runner-up, Paramus 108-pounder Glenn Hodgins, 10-6, in the second round.

Triant and Ross both lost in the third round, but made sizable ripples in the tournament pond before exiting. Mackert and Esposito are in the semis.

Pascack Valley was the surprise team, moving three wrestlers into the semis and rising to third place with 85 points.

Fourth-year varsity wrestler Eric Beyer made it at 122 with two pins and a shutout; Dave Perini had three pins at 135; and Glenn Unger surprised with a 35second pin of Bergenfield's Vin Mejia at 158 after recording a pin and a 20-4 superior decision.

"Steve Vedral, who won a Park Ridge Tournament championship for us at 158, volunteered to drop down to 148," said PV coach Ken Sarajian of the way the stage was set for Unger. "Vedral wound up with the bad draw, [Pascack Hills's defending champion Tom] Pepe in the second round and lost."

The top riches-to-rags story belonged to Northern Highlands, which advanced 11 of 12 wrestlers to the second round, four to the third Found, and none to the semis.

"We hit three or four kids in the second round who'll probably win it," said Highlander coach Fred Procopio. "But that's the way it goes in a tournament of this magnitude."

Bergenfield's chances for a team title dimmed early. The quarterfinal bouts began at 8 p.m., but by 8:19, the situation was desperate. Dumont's Mike Vietri edged Brian Becker, 6-3, at 115; and Bears 122-pounder Tony Marsilio had to default due to a shoulder injury, while Mike Palazzolo and Tony Van Horn were winning for Hills. Walter Mearns and Gary Miuccio rallied the Bears, but at 9:13 p.m., PV's Unger pinned Mejia.

The top Bear was Pete Georgoutsos, third in the State last year, who pinned all three opponents in the first period of his 188-pound bouts.

Another of the night's youthful surprises was Paramus soph Larry Goodman, who pinned twice to reach the semis of the powerful 115 class. That talented division included 11 wrestlers who qualified to be seeded.

Goodman spoke like a seasoned veteran when his semifinal opponent, Van Horn, was mentioned. "First I have to make weight tomorrow," the 10th-grader said, laughing. "Then I'll worry about the



Pascack Hills limited to team honors

championship had been decided long before Cliffside Park's Bill Blume and Ridgefield Park's Pete Gonzalez sought their own rewards last night in the Bergen County Coaches Holiday Wrestling Tournament. They weren't concerned that Pascack Hills wrestlers stood between them and their championship dreams.

"I've got to get ready in my mind, no matter who I'm wrestling," said Mume. "I just knew the guy was good, no matter where he's from."

Gonzalez received the Paul Tashian Memorial Trophy as the meet's Most Outstanding Wrestler after defeating Tony Van Horn of Mills, 4-2, in the 115 title bout. Drume unleashed a variety of throws to appet Jim Freeman of the Cowboys, 15-8.

Wrestling

With its only two finalists losing, Paccack Hills became the first achool in the tournament's 23 years to win the team championship without having an individual champion. Six Cowboys reached the semifinals, but none won titles.

"At least we had two. That helps," said Roy Marada, coach of Bergenfeld, the only team with multiple champions. Gary Miuccio (129) and Pete Georgoutsos (188) won for the Bears, who finished second with 139 to points to the Cowboys' 157 1/2.

The title bouts went as follows:

101: "Tommy proved today he has nots," said new Lyndhurst coach Mark Zarro after Tom Dunn of the Colden Bears overcame shoulder miseries to win, 9-3, against Cliff-side Park's Mark Piterski. Seemingly caught in a single-leg, Dunn scored a takedown on a headlock-whizzer 1:03 into the match. Dunn added two takedowns and five back points.

tricken with spinal meningitis in the fall, had three pins and a major decision in earlier bouts before nipping Hackensack rookie Ralph Dass, 4-2. Burns used a stepover takedown with 1:16 left in the first period and hooked in a grapevine in the third.

115: Genzalez prevailed in the toughest weight class. He rallied from a a hard-switch reversal by Van Horn, a Park Ridge transfer who scored 24 points for Hills in the tournament. Gonzalez countered a Peterson for the tying takedown at the 30-second mark of the second, and picked up a stalling point.

122: Fair Lawn's John Kamens used two first-period reversals and four second-period back points off a cradle and a tilt for an 8-6 win over Pascack Valley's Eric Beyer. The latter turned Kamens to his back with 52 seconds left, but Kamens bridged and survived.

129: Miuccio's deep single-leg at 1:05 of the first period stood up. He added a switch reversal and a stalling point for a 5-1 defeat of St. Joseph's Jim Purcell.

135: Blume used several judo throws to drop Freeman and built a 10-2 lead in the first period. Blume had three pins (two in under a minute) and a major decision earlier.

141: Chris Slechta of Ridgefield took a 1-0 lead with a sitout at 1:51 of the second period. Fair Lawn's top-seeded Todd Anderson was forced to default 33 seconds later after suffering a gashed forehead during a collision.

148: Dave Van Tine of Palisades Park pinned four previous opponents before winning 4-2 over Rutherford's Gary LiSanti. The latter, who ousted defending champ Tom Pepe of Pascack Hills in the semis, was turned by Van Tine with eight seconds remaining after a cradle by the Rutherford junior was disallowed because it was considered "potentially dangerous."

158: Steve Cascio of Westwood recorded an escape in the third overtime period for a 1-0 win, his second tight victory over Dumont's Mike Licata in two weeks. Licata's takedown points were tied by two Cascio escapes in regulation.

170: North Bergen's John Bott, who won the tournament's pin trophy with four falls in only 7:04, conducted a takedown clinic to lead Ramsey's Todd MacGlashan, 13-3, before pinning him at 3:49 on a tilt with legs.

188: Georgoutsos worked legs wondrously, countering a gramby roll by Cliffside Park's John Chakonis för a 4-0 lead, adding a throw and four stalling points for the 11-0 romp.

Unlimited: Bergen Catholic's Steve Steele had two takedowns, an escape, and a double-leg turn for a reverse to defeat Kurt Pfeifer of Fair Lawn, 8-2. Pfeifer pinned four, including Paramus Catholic's Charlie Strobel in the semis.


